

During the Visit

- Team members' temperatures will be taken upon arrival and periodically during the stay.
 - Team members with medical experience are encouraged to assist with temperature and symptom monitoring.
 - Individuals with high temperatures or experiencing other COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival will not be permitted to enter The Hope Center. However, they will be referred to a local medical facility for treatment.
 - Temperatures and symptoms will be monitored each morning and records will be kept in a secure place.
- 5 people per room. Maximum team size is 20.
 - To ensure social distancing, team member sleeping arrangement is 1 person per bunk bed.
 - Team members are encouraged to practice social distancing at all times.
- Showers and bathrooms must be cleaned after each use
 - There is a 2-person maximum using shower room at a time.
 - End showers will be used only. Middle showers will be blocked off.
 - Only three sinks per side will be used with a request to wipe down after each use with supplied wipes.
 - Team leader will designate a team member to clean during the stay.
 - Cleaning supplies will be provided by the Hope Center.
 - Teams are encouraged to bring additional cleaning supplies.
- High traffic areas will be cleaned frequently throughout the day.
 - Designated team members are encouraged to assist BGM with cleaning high traffic areas (door knobs, keypads, stove, etc.).
- Wearing a mask inside the Hope Center
 - Team members have the option of wearing a mask while in common areas or any place inside the Hope Center.
 - BGM staff may also wear masks.
 - All participants (BGM Staff, Team members, Project Participants etc.) will continue to practice social distancing by staying 6 feet away from each other at all times.
 - Each person is encouraged to wash hands and use hand sanitizer frequently and follow safe social distancing inside and around the Hope Center.
